Alexander Döring, Secretary General of FEFAC

Alexander Döring graduated as an Agricultural Economist from the University of Bonn in 1991. He is Secretary General of FEFAC, the European Feed Manufacturers' Federation and was appointed in 1994. As FEFAC Secretary General, he represents the interests of the European feed industry at meetings with the European Commission, the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) and the European Food and Veterinary Office (FVO). He oversees the work of the FEFAC team on a wide range of policy issues from Feed Hygiene and Feed Safety management to sustainability issues and economics. He also represents FEFAC at international level, attending meetings of institutions such as Codex Alimentarius, FAO, OIE and IFIF.

Gustavo Idigoras, President Argentine Edible Oil Association, Grain Exporters Association (CIARA-CEC)

As President of CIARA-CEC, Gustavo represents the exporters and crushing industry which make up 48% of national exports and conduct trade worth \$30 billion annually. He has a degree in political sciences, a master degree in International Affairs and Business and a PhD in Agricultural Business Administration.

Gustavo previously worked as Public Affairs manager for MONSANTO and was Director of Business Issue Management (A Consultant group on agribusiness and bioenergies in Argentina) working for different chambers and companies related to food business and biofuels. He is an International Consultant working for WTO, IDB and FAO on SPS and agriculture trade including sustainability.

He was a government negotiator for 18 years on trade and market access issues at WTO, MERCOSUR, FTAs, CODEX, OIE, IPPC, IGC and OECD. He also served as Argentina's Agricultural Counsellor in the European Union and was based in Belgium for 5 years.

Ana Yaluff is Sustainability Manager for ADM (Europe, Middle East, Africa and India). Ana has close to 10 years of experience in the sustainability field, working in the food production industry, skilled in sustainable businesses, corporate social responsibility, stakeholder engagement and agricultural supply chains. She earned a professional Master in International Economics from Sorbonne Nouvelle University in Paris, France and a Postgraduate Certificate in Sustainable Value Chains from the Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership in England.
