Importation of medicated feed

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What is medicated feed?



- 'Medicated feedingstuffs' is mixture of an animal remedy and a feed intended to be fed to animals without further processing
- These animal remedies are veterinary medicinal products intended for, and authorised for this use





What legislation applies?



Council Directive 90/167/EEC

- S.I. No. 176 of 1994 Regulation 13 covers importation from a third country
- This legislation will be repealed on January 28, 2022 by a new European Regulation, Regulation (EU) 2019/4

What are the requirements under Regulation 13 of S.I. No. 176 of 1994?

Import from a third country requires a licence

Feed must be manufactured to equivalent standards as those required

by these regulations

An authorised medicinal premix must be used

VPA or EU number

- Requirements do not apply to feed from Northern Ireland (NI)
 - treated as EU territory under NI Protocol





Key Takeaway Messages



- 1. Medicated feed is subject to all the general import requirements for compound feed
- Medicated feed is also subject to Animal By-Product (ABP) requirements if the feed contains an Animal By-Product
- 3. These requirements must be in order in addition to obtaining a Medicated Feed Import Licence.
